## A message from the St. Mary by the Sea, Uganda Team, January 23, 2025

Thank you all for your generous 2024 donations to the St. Aloysius Secondary School for girls in Uganda scholarship program. We know there are many worthy programs to support and we appreciate that you include St. Aloysius in your charitable giving! Even though we did not make our very lofty goal of \$60,000, we were able to send \$45,688 for scholarships this year! This funded 212 students in various amounts depending on their needs. Sister knew early on that we would be short. She said that they would tighten their belts and make it work to finish this year. Our St. Aloysius Team voted to set the 2025 goal for scholarship fundraising to \$45,000 which will still be a challenge!

This year marks our tenth year of providing scholarships and we are overwhelmed to see the wonderful results of some of our girls. Two of our first young scholarship recipients went on to secure government scholarships for the university. Many other of our scholarship students have been able to graduate from universities or have joined trade school professions.

Please read a letter from Maltina (pg 2), one of our students who graduated with honors but was struggling to take her university business classes without a computer. We met Maltina at St. Aloysius when we visited in 2019. One of our very generous donors gave extra money for a computer. She recently sent an email saying that she has graduated from the university and now has a great job.

Take time to read other letters from our scholarship S6 students who have just graduated and are waiting to receive their scores from the government testing in November. Enjoy their gratefulness and their hopes for the future!

We are making plans to be more innovative in our fundraising this year and continue our scholarship support to needy girls who are begging for help to receive a high school education. So many of these girls come from single parent families where the mother or grandmothers are often their sole support. Others are from poor families who can barely put food on the table each day.
