We have not yet heard of any cases in our area, but now the government is prohibiting us from holding parent meetings and any visitations at our campus. We had plans of inviting our parents here on 11 July as we do each year. Now that too is canceled. Although we are not hearing of Ebola cases in Uganda, the government is being cautious.

She is back at the S5 (11th grade) level with one more year to go. I bought her a full regalia outfit to receive this honor voted by the student body. All the student leaders received vests so they could stand out.

May our provident God bless you abundantly, enrich your lives, and reward your generosity.

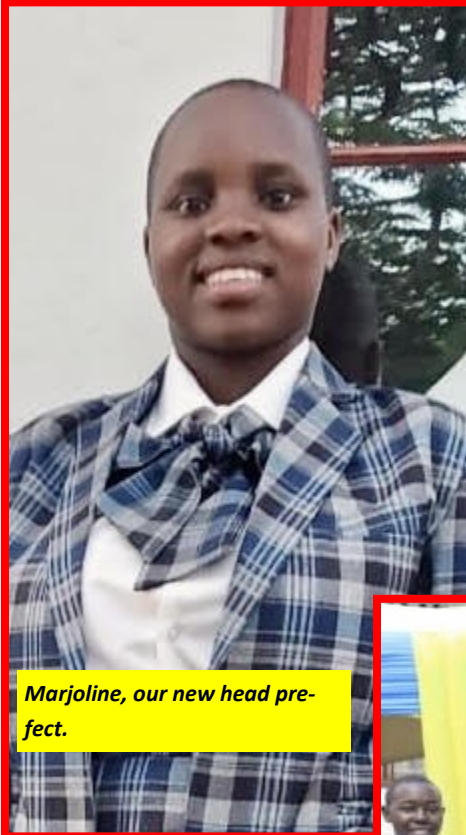
