I am here today not just as a student from St. Aloysius, but as living testimony of what your compassion and sacrifice can do. I grew up an orphan starting in primary school in Uganda. Like many girls in my situation, high school education often felt like a distant dream. Because of your generosity, I qualified for a partial scholarship from your program, and I was able to complete my studies from Senior One to Senior Four at St. Aloysius.

That opportunity gave me so much more than just academics. I received hope for a future. It gave me dignity that I have value, and it gave me a purpose.

After completing S4, I was blessed to be brought to the United States by my Uncle Joseph who had been paying my other half of tuition fees and lives in Texas. Today, by the grace of God and continued hard work, I have been admitted to the University of Texas at Arlington where I will be pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Nursing while continuing to live with my uncle.
