

#### <u>A Little Bit of History</u>

Some years ago, a mission project fell into our lap at St. Mary by the Sea! It was brought to us by two sisters who were members of the Daughters of Mary, an order of African sisters dedicated to serving the women, children, and poor of Uganda and Kenya. These two sisters had received a scholarship from Seattle University and came to Rockaway to visit us by invitation of our priest at that time.

After hearing their message, a group of us from St. Mary by the Sea formed a team to help one secondary school in Uganda that served needy young women (the Uganda government does not provide free education above primary school).

Our mission became to educate girls who come from families too poor to pay for their daughters to attend secondary school but do have high test scores. In 2019, two members of our church traveled to Uganda to visit this school and see firsthand their needs. They found the young students so thankful to receive our help through upgrading their school facilities and providing over 250, mostly partial, scholarships. The women of Uganda struggle to improve their lives against many odds.

Now over 10 years later, we have seen many of our students graduate from high school, college and even medical school! Others have started businesses or have gone back to their villages and become leaders in their communities. An educated girl can help change their entire family's ability to make a living. Thank you to you, the many donors, who help to see these needy girls' dreams come true by providing scholarships to get a high school education.
